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Research Design and Demographics

Research Design


WPA Intelligence conducted a survey of adults in the City of New Orleans.

WPAi selected a random sample of adults living in New Orleans. Respondents were screened to ensure that they were neither a member of the news media or a public relations company. The sample for this survey was stratified based on geography, age, gender, education, and ethnicity. This methodology allows us to avoid post-survey "weighting" which can reduce the reliability of survey results.

Respondents were contacted by phone via a live telephone operator interview (36% cell phone interviews) September 5-7, 2016. The study has a sample size of n=601 adults (75 adults per District) with a margin of error of $\pm 4.0\%$ in 95 out of 100 cases.

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


Police Department Satisfaction

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Overall satisfaction with the New Orleans Police Department is down by 13 points since last year, slightly below the overall average since March 2013.




Overall Satisfaction with NOPD

Just over half of adults in New Orleans (51%) are satisfied with the New Orleans Police Department.



Satisfaction is down in District 2 (54%, -15 points), District 3 (39%, -18 points), and District 4 (43%, -23 points).



The largest decrease in satisfaction is in District 6 (38%, -29 points).


District 8 (72%) is the most satisfied of all police Districts.

There is little difference among white (53%, -4 points) and black adults (51%, -15%), although satisfaction is down among both.

Satisfaction is highest among white adults in District 8 (81%) and highest among black adults in District 1 (82%).




Satisfaction with how the NOPD is handling Violent Crime (39%) is down twenty points.


Decreases in satisfaction in the way New Orleans Police Department deals with violent crime correlates with the murder rate increase during a similar time frame.




Satisfaction with the Police Department's honesty and integrity (57%, -11 points) and overall competence (56%, -12 points) are both down.

The aspect of the New Orleans Police Department's job that has the highest satisfaction is cooperation with the public (58%), followed closely by honesty and integrity (57%).



Both black (55%) and white (62%) adults tend to be satisfied with cooperation with the public, while white (67%) adults tend to be most satisfied with their honesty and integrity.



Black (47%) and white (43%) adults tend to be most unsatisfied with the NOPD's handling of violent crime, followed closely with their response times and their ability to keep drugs of the streets.



Unsatisfied by Ethnicity




Satisfaction with the New Orleans Police Department's performance in the respondent's neighborhood remains high (63%), but is down seven points.


Nearly two-in-three adults in New Orleans (63%) are satisfied with police performance in their neighborhood.


Neighborhood satisfaction is highest in District 1 (81%) and District 8 (79%).


Neighborhood satisfaction is down by thirty-three points in District 4 (44%).

Neighborhood satisfaction continues to rise in District 8 (79%).



Neighborhood satisfaction is down seven points among black adults (62%) and two points among white adults (69%) in New Orleans.



Neighborhood Satisfaction by Ethnicity



Neighborhood satisfaction is high among both white (86%) and black (90%) adults in District 1. Satisfaction is equally low in District 4 among both black and white adults.

Satisfaction by Ethnicity

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A factor contributing to a decrease in neighborhood satisfaction may be the steady decrease in the size of the New Orleans Police force, while population continues to rise.



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
Neighborhood Safety

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Just over four-in-five adults (82%) feel safe in their own neighborhood, slightly higher than the average since March 2013.



A strong majority of adults in each District feel safe in their own neighborhood.

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


Just over half of adults say they feel safe outside of their neighborhood (51%), the highest it has been since August 2013.

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


Interaction with New Orleans Police Department

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Despite a steady increase in personal and property crimes, interaction with the police department (28%) is down twelve points since last year; however, this is close to the average since March 2013.

Seven-in-ten (70%) of the police encounters were initiated by the respondents.



A strong majority of respondents were satisfied with the way the situation was handled (71%), four points above the average since 2013.

17. Overall, would you say that you are satisfied or unsatisfied with the way the police officer handled your situation? (n=166)




Nine-in-ten (90%) respondents say they have not called or visited the New Orleans Police Station in the past twelve months.

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Employees at New Orleans Police Stations (n=58)

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
Crime Stoppers

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Four-in-five adults (80%) are familiar with Crimestoppers, down two points since last year.


Crimestoppers is most well known in District 3 (90%).

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Summary and Recommendations

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Summary and Recommendations

Overall Satisfaction

- Overall satisfaction (51%) is down by 13 points, slightly below the average since March 2013.
- Overall satisfaction remains similar between whites (53%) and blacks (51%), although satisfaction for both is down; satisfaction varies significantly district by district.
- The biggest declines in satisfaction are in District 2 (54%, -15 points), District 3 (39%, -18 points), District 4 (43%, -23 points), and District 6 (38%, -29 points).
- Satisfaction with handling violent crime (39%) is down the most, decreasing by twenty points; likely due to increase in murder rate at time of survey.
- Adults are more satisfied with police performance in their own neighborhoods (63%), although neighborhood satisfaction is down by thirty three points in District 4 (44%).
- The aspect of the New Orleans Police Department's job that has the highest satisfaction is cooperation with the public (58%), followed closely by honesty and integrity (57%).

Overall Experience

- Significant feeling of safety in own neighborhoods (82%) as compared to outside own neighborhoods (51%).
- First time since August '13 a majority feel safe visiting other areas of New Orleans outside of own neighborhoods.
- Interaction with police remains strongly positive (71%), four points higher than the average since 2013, but interaction with police is down 12 points (28%).



Summary and Recommendations

Perceptions vs Experience

- Overall results reflect public perception of crime at the time the survey was taken.
- But personal experience of respondents, whether in own feelings of safety or through interactions with police, has increased since last year and is above the four year average.
- District 4 is driving down the overall perception and experience numbers.
